## Mission Update: Hope Village (Mike Cohoon/Jan Drehmel)

\* Jan read Mike Cohoon's report stating that Hope Village's Capital Campaign is complete with 192 different contributors for \$2.8 million. It will be several years before all funds are received.

\* About 150 people attended the groundbreaking ceremony to celebrate the success of the campaign and the start of construction on the duplexes and 6-plex.

\* The Chippewa Falls Green Team, consisting of 3 senior girls, were successful in writing a grant to install solar panels at the Hope Village site. This will provide energy to the community center and 10 Tiny Houses for a savings of \$350,000 over the life of the panels.

\* There will be a thrift sale at the community center on Thursday-Saturday 9/12-9/14.

\* In the last 2 weeks, 3 households successfully moved into permanent housing. Currently 10 children live at the village.

\* The Saver's clothing drive earned \$2,764.

\* Hope Village is hiring an Assistant to the Director and is presently accepting applications.

\*Hope Village has access to a \$1.5 million grant to convert a building into affordable housing. If you know of a building that may be appropriate for this effort please contact Mike ...
